### DO'S

### DON'TS

Treat your acrylic as a structural element!



Treat it just as a viewing window

Always use gentle cleaners such as mild soap or acrylic cleaner



Avoid harsh chemicals that are commonly used on windows

Work with experienced manufacturer and installer to ensure you are getting a quality product



Assume that all acrylic manufacturers or installers are the same

Use it for what it was designed for, never change the purpose unless you consult with who manufactured the acrylic



No new loads.  
No new temperatures  
No new water chemicals  
Don't change it from original purpose

Inspect your acrylic on a regular basis and contact your manufacturer or installer if you notice anything out of the ordinary



Ignore your acrylic as if it will just stay the same

Understand what you bought...  
The Product  
The Service  
The Warranty



Assume they are all the same. Acrylic, Installs and Warranties differ in the industry

Have your acrylic inspected by a professional periodically



Assume all is ok. Regular inspections must be apart of your investment

Repairs must be done by an acrylic professional. If Reynolds manufactured the acrylic, your warranty will void if not done by us.



Hire anyone that says they can do it. Work by others can affect the performance of the acrylic and warranty.
